CRITERIA

Period covered is 1 April 2009 through 31 March 2010

Membership in the NSA is not a requirement for nomination.

Members and non-members of the NSA may nominate an individual for consideration.

Aviator of the Year:

Self-explanatory

Non-Commissioned Officer of the Year:

Determined by Regiment NCO of the Year Competition

Soldier of the Year:

Determined by Regiment Soldier of the Year Competition

Officer of the Year:

Nominees will not have served in an aviator position during the nomination period. Battalion and Regiment Aviation Staff Officer may be submitted for this category.

Civilian of the Year:

Nominees must have served in a civil service or contractor position and made a contribution to the 160th SOAR during the nomination period.

Volunteer of the Year:

Nominees must have made a contribution to the Regiment in a volunteer capacity during the nomination period.

Aviation Mechanic of the Year:

Nominees must have served in at least one of the following MOS's: 15 series, 44B, or 44E, during the nomination period. ** Excluding those serving on Full Crew member status

Ground Mechanic of the Year:

Nominees need to have served in at least one of the following MOS's: 52 and 63 series during the nomination period.

Non-Rated Crewmember of the Year Award:

Nominees must have served in the rank of E-3 through E-6, on Full Non Rated Crewmember status during the nomination period, and in one of the following MOS's: 15S, 15T, or 15U. It is conceivable that the Awardee could have been promoted by the time of the actual award ceremony.

Avionics Maintainer of the Year Award:

Nominees must have served in an Avionics MOS/position during the nomination period.

Three-Five Gas and Guns Maintainer of the Year Award:

Nominees must have served in an Armorer, POL, Armament, or Ammunition handler position during the nomination period.
